## **Dade County Receives Proposals for Elections Building Project**

**TRENTON, Ga. (August 8, 2025)** — The Dade County Board of Commissioners received seven official proposals for the construction of a new elections building following the advertised opening at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 7, 2025. Chairman Don Townsend announced the opening during the August Commission meeting.

Prior to the official bid opening, a pre-bid meeting was held in which eleven companies participated and were pre-qualified to submit proposals for the project.

Of the seven proposals received, one submission was deemed incomplete and subsequently disqualified. The County is now in the process of thoroughly reviewing the six remaining qualified proposals.

“We appreciate the response from the contracting community and are committed to a careful and transparent review process,” said Chairman Don Townsend. “This project is an important step forward for our election operations in Dade County.”

County officials will complete their due diligence over the next 30 days and anticipate reaching a decision within that time frame.
